- 4. ACM Minutes 2018: It was proposed by Malcolm Keysell and seconded by Richard Skirving that the Minutes of the Council Meeting held on 16 June 2018 be declared accurate, which was approved *nem con*.
- 5. Matters Arising: There was a brief discussion about the valuation of stock in the accounts for the previous year and why they were not stated as it was thought to have been agreed.
- 6. Consideration of the Annual Report of the Association: Contributors were asked to update their annual reports if desired:
 - Development: there has been no progress in relation to a 50m pool for Kent
 - Disability/Para-Swimming: a committee set up with Steve Hunter as the Manger
 - Diving: thanks were given to Chris Snode for his efforts as Manager, and a new manager was being sought
 - Masters: there were 17% more KCASA entries and 40% medals at British Masters in 2020
 - Open Water: thanks were given to Karen Crabtree for her efforts as Manager, and a new manager was being sought
 - Swimming: Kent now only has one weekend at the LAC for the 2020 Swimming Championships rather than two. Timothy Leberl was selected to represent Mauritius
 - Swimming Officials: there is currently no further update about the new J1 courses

It was agreed to delete the part of the Annual Report referring to Kent Swimming Champs finances regarding pool hire costs (Page 2 paragraph two)

It was proposed by Alan Davidson and seconded by Neil Kerr that the Annual Report be adopted with this amendment, and it was approved by a majority.

- 7. Consideration of the Annual Report of the Association: There was much discussion here and it was agreed that the Accounts need to be readjusted due to errors. In view of this is was felt that the Accounts could not be considered at this meeting and that a Special Council Meeting (SCM) would need to be convened to do so in the future. In addition, it was agreed that a letter needs to be sent to Auditors Gilbert Allen pointing out their oversight of a least one numerical error
- 8. Examiners: In the light of Point 7 above, the appointment of Gilbert Allen & Co of Tonbridge as Examiners of the Association's Accounts will be approved at the SCM
- 9. Proposed amendments to the Constitution of the Association:

Proposal 1: That the Constitution is amended to reflect a three-year term for Management Committee members, the rotation of which will be decided by the Management Committee ready for the ACM in 2020.

It was proposed by Richard Skirving and seconded by Verhoorevort that the Proposal be adopted, and approved *nem con*. However, questions were raised in relation to the subsequent proposals which, in the absence of the General Secretary, could not be clarified in detail. It was therefore agreed to withdraw the agreement to Proposal 1 and take forward the whole set of proposals to the SCM.
