(Disability/Para Swimming, Masters Swimming, Open Water Swimming, Speed Swimming); to support the discipline managers in the development of their discipline; work with the discipline managers and Development Co-ordinator to ensure that development plans are appropriate and

achievable; produce an annual report;

an effective team membergood management skills

Time commitment: • as a KCASA Council member, attend the Annual Council Meeting (2 hours)

attendance at KCASA Management Committee meetings (six per year x 2 hours)

attendance at KCASA Swimming Committee meetings (approx three per year x 2 hours)

1-2 hours per month on administration tasks

Key tasks:

- To head the Swimming Committee which will include the Disability/Para Swimming, Masters Swimming, Open Water Swimming, Speed Swimming managers, the Swimming Officials Co-ordinator, the Swimming Records Administrator and other members as necessary
- To act as a point of liaison between the swimming disciplines identifying common ground and cross-discipline support
